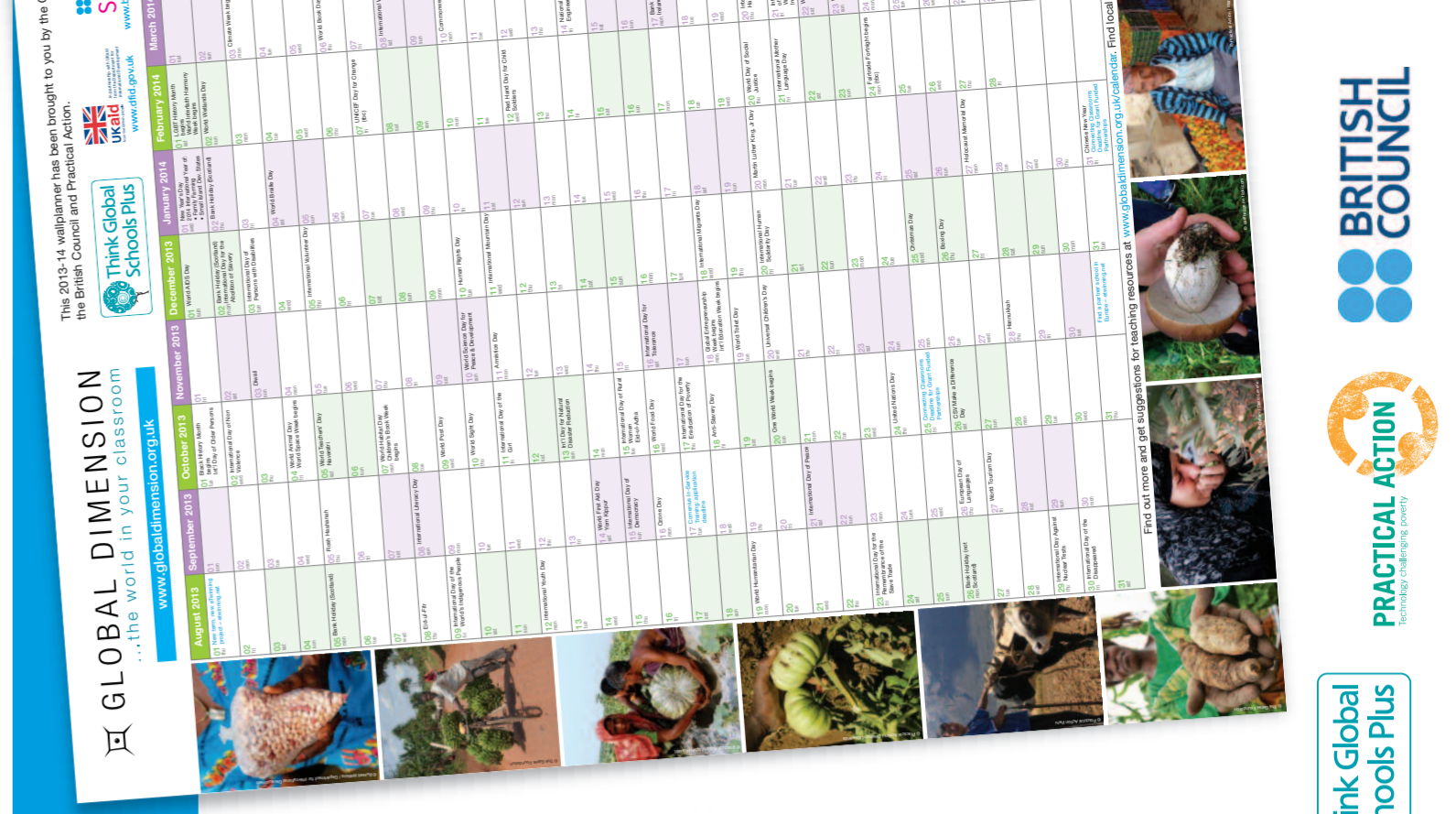
Global Wallplanner 2013-14
